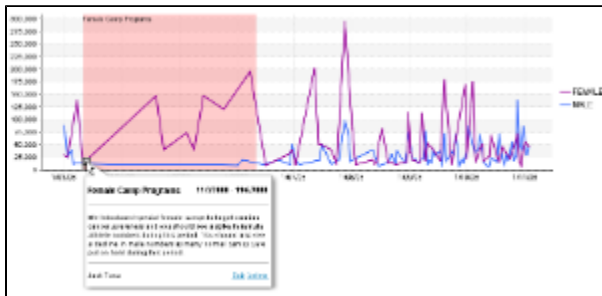
Discussions
